


## Gift Bag Card – Class 37 - 2022



### SUPPLIES

QTY	PRODUCT	A6 CARD	DESCRIPTION
1	* Card Base	14.8cm x 21cm (A5) (5 7/8" x 8 1/4")	I used White but you can use any colour that you like
1	Cardstock	14.3cm x 10cm Metric Rectangle 2 (5 5/8" x 4")	I used J Burrows (light weight) cardstock but, you can use paper for this piece as it is just a backing piece
1	* Patterned Paper	15cm x 15cm (6" x 6")	This is for the bag on the inside. NOTE: a standard 6" x 6" sheet is 15.2cm x 15.2cm – it makes it easier if you are working in metric to cut it down to 15cm x 15cm. Inches people can leave it at 6" x 6". A heavier weight paper is best here – a 160gsm is perfect
2	Patterned paper	14.3cm x 10cm Metric Rectangle 2 (5 5/8" x 4")	Choose 2 different papers that will co-ordinate with the paper that you are using for the bag. Keep the left over papers with these pieces as you might want to use them for extra decoration on the inside of the card.
2	String or Ribbon	Approx: 13cm each	Any colour that goes with the patterned paper
	Embellishments		Any that you like – I used some images that were fussy cut from the paper that I used for the front of the card

\* Have extra of these two pieces for your template that we will be making first. I used J Burrows 250gsm (light weight) for my template.
