



International Cardmaking Day – Class 31 - 2021



SUPPLIES

QTY	PRODUCT	MEASUREMENT	DESCRIPTION
1	Card base	21cm x 14.8cm (A5) (5 ⁷ / ₈ " x 8 ¹ / ₄ ")	This will be the card base – Fold in half to make an A6 card base. In the example, I have used white but you can use any colour.
1	Cardstock	14.3cm x 10cm (Metric Rectangle 2) 5 ⁵ / ₈ " x 3 ¹⁵ / ₁₆ "	This is the matt layer. I also used green in the example – but pick a colour that goes with your patterned paper
1	Patterned Paper	13.8cm x 9.5cm (Metric Rectangle 3) 5 ¹ / ₂ " x 3 ³ / ₄ "	This can be any patterned paper or even old book paper or music paper – whatever you want. I went with a Christmas theme, but you can go with any theme is suitable for you.
2	Patterned Paper	2.5cm x 2.5cm 1" x 1"	This will need to be a co-ordinating colour to the patterned paper. My paper was double sided so I used the other side.
	Cardstock Strips	½ cm wide ¼"	In the example, I used the green cardstock that I also used for my matt layer. Each one of these strips need to be approx. 6cm long but just cut them from any scraps you have as they will be trimmed once they are attached to your card.
1	Patterned paper OR cardstock	6.5cm x 6.5cm 2 ¹ / ₂ " x 2 ¹ / ₂ "	This will be the centre piece of your card – I cut mine into a circle, but you can cut it to be any shape that you want
1	Embellishment		I used a small Christmas tree that I stamped and coloured in and then stuck on a small circle with foam tape. You can use whatever you have to suit the theme of your card.
