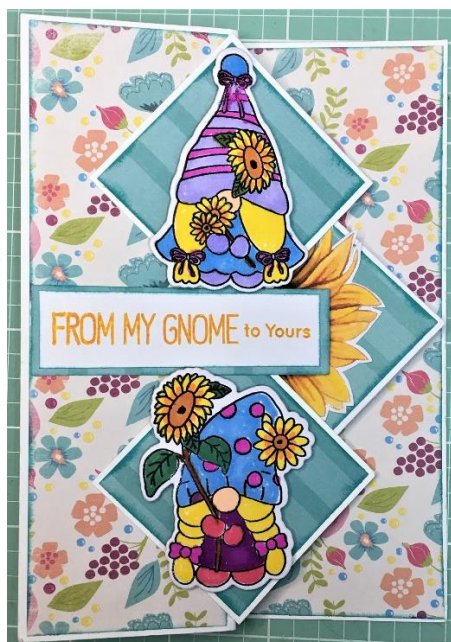


## Diamond Pop-Out Card – Class 24 - 2022



### SUPPLIES

QTY	PRODUCT	A6 CARD	DESCRIPTION
1	Card Base	14.8cm x 21cm (A5) (5 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 8 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " )	Folded in half to make an A6 card base. The example is white.
1	Patterned paper	14.3cm x 10cm Metric Rectangle 2 5 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 4"	This piece is for the inside of the card. In the example, this piece is the same as the one that was used on the front of the card.
1	Patterned paper	14.3cm x 4.8cm 5 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 1 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> "	This is for the front of the card – in the example, this is the piece that is the same as the previous one
1	Patterned Paper	14.3cm x 4.8cm 5 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 1 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> "	This piece is for the inside front of the card. In the example this paper is the same as was used for the matt layer on our diamonds
2	Card stock	5cm x 5cm (2" x 2")	These will be the 'diamonds' on the front of the card. In the example, they are white
1	Card stock	7cm x 7cm (2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " )	This is for the larger 'diamond' that will be attached to the pop-up block on the inside of the card
2	Patterned Paper	4.7cm x 4.7cm (1 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 1 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " )	These are for the matt layer on the 'diamonds' on the front of the card. In the example, the same paper was used for the matt layers as on the inside front of the card.
1	Patterned Paper	6.7cm x 6.7cm (2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " )	This piece is for the larger diamond. In the example, the same paper was used as on the smaller diamonds.
1	Card stock	10cm x 7cm (4" x 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " )	This is for the pop-up block / feature.
