## <u>SUPPLIES</u>

QTY	PRODUCT	A6 CARD	DESCRIPTION
1	Card Base	14.8cm x 21cm (A5) (5 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 8 ¼")	l used a white card base.
1	Plain or lightly patterned paper	14.3cm x 10cm Metric Rectangle 2 $(5 \frac{5}{8}" \times 4")$	This will be the background frame for all of the layers of our card
1	Patterned Paper	13.8cm x 9.5cm Metric Rectangle 3 (5 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 3 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> ")	I found it best to pick a highly patterned paper or one that has a photo / scene image on it. This will be the main focus of your card
	Greetings		I stamped mine but you can use pre-printed greeting strips or a die cut greeting.
	White Card	Scraps	To stamp your greeting on
